RETURN TO PLAY

Visiting the RBC Wealth Management Dominion Securities Arena

When visiting the arena, all users must complete a declaration form on the day of their visit.

*****THIS MUST BE COMPLETED EVERY DAY BEFORE YOU ENTER THE RINK**

You can do this online or on the paper forms located at the entrance of the arena.

This form must be filled out each day you visit the arena.

Arrive no earlier than 20 minutes before your rental. You will have 20 minutes in your dressing room after your rental.

If you arrive earlier than your access times, line up in the designated area – 2M or 6Ft apart unless you are from the same household.

Follow all posted Enter and Exit signs.

When entering the facility, you are required to utilize the hand sanitizer located at the entrance and check-in with a staff member who will confirm you have completed our declaration and direct you to your area.

Masks

Masks are required in all common areas of the Club. You may only remove your mask once you are participating in your activity.

Spectators must wear a mask at all times.



Spectators

1 Adult guardian is permitted for any youth players 15 and under.

Maximum 2 spectators are permitted for participants 16+.

Spectators must wear a mask at all times.

Spectators also require a declaration to be completed.

All spectators that do not need to help their child with dressing should go directly into the designated seating areas – you will sit in the bleachers with the clearly marked spots or in the Ice Café viewing area – 2M or 6Ft apart unless you are from the same household.

If you need to bring a sibling, they must sit with you in the designated spectator seating areas at all times.

We ask that you do not stand at the glass, but instead go directly to your seat, if you are not ready to sit in the rink you must wait outside the building.

All spectators must follow provincial health guidelines and keep their physical distance of 2M (6ft).

If your child requires assistance taking off their equipment, please assist them quickly and exit the facility promptly.

If your child is independent, stay seated until they have come out of the dressing room and exit the facility promptly or wait outside.

No gathering outside of the arena doors or on our grounds.

Safety Practices

With our extensive protocols and procedures, our staff is trained and ready to focus on your health and safety, so you can enjoy the game you love.

Arrive no earlier than 20 minutes before your rental. You will have 20 minutes in your dressing room after your rental.

Gathering in Groups- Congregating in groups is not permitted in the facility or on our grounds.

Maximum 30 people on ice.

Dressing rooms

- Arena dressing rooms will be assigned with 2 rooms per rental group.
- Showers in the arena dressing rooms are available

- Please note dressing room areas are not secure, so we ask that all valuables be kept at home.

No spitting.

Regularly and thoroughly wash or sanitize your hands and avoid or minimize contact with objects and surfaces. Please cough or sneeze into your elbow and away from others. Hand sanitizer stations will be located throughout the facility.

Following completion of your game, we ask that you remove all garbage and personal belongings from the area and depart the facility. Post-game gathering is not permitted at this time.

All arena users are instructed to stay home if they do not feel well, have a cough, shortness of breath, or other known symptoms of COVID-19.



Your dressing room space will be sanitized prior to every use. We ask that players do not share supplies at this time.

Public access washrooms will also be cleaned on a more regular basis when programming is taking place.
